**2009 NYS Grade 4 ELA 672 AND 2009 NYS Grade 4 Math 688**

Driving Directions: Beach Channel Drive to Seaside Avenue (B103 Street), turn south toward elevated train line, park vehicle on Beach Channel Dr., Seaside Avenue, or Beach 104 Street. Enter at Seaside Avenue or B104 Street.
